COMMUNITY SCARECROW COMPETITION

RULES & ENTRY FORM

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES:

Registration is \$25 and is open to any business. Registration includes a stake for you scarecrow and a bag of straw. We encourage all participating businesses to plan to display their scarecrows in the mall for the entire month of October.

JUDGING:

There will be a public voting box located at Save On Foods. Voting will start on October 1st and end on October 16th. Voter can use the paper drop box located at the customer service counter in Save-On or use the online QR code to vote. Each business **MUST** name their scarecrow with an appropriate sign for voters to identify.

DROP OFF:

Each business can drop off their scarecrow at their convenience to the Greenwood mall. Keep in mind that voting begins on October 1st. Place your scarecrow and display along the wall but please do not constrict windows/entrances to other businesses.

PICK-UP:

Each participating business will be responsible for delivery and pickup of their scarecrow to the Greenwood Mall (Pick up deadline on November 1). It is okay if you need to pick up prior to this date but your business is encouraged to keep your scarecrow on display for the month of October.

SCARECROW GUIDELINES:

- Scarecrows must be built to be self-supporting,
- Scarecrows must be no taller than 8 ft. and no shorter than 3 ft,
- Must not contain any live plant material in the design,
- Entries must be suitable for viewing by small children. Any entries reflecting controversial subject matter will not be accepted: All entries should exhibit good taste for family viewing,
- Neither the Chamber or Greenwood Mall is not responsible for loss or damage to scarecrow while on display or during pick-up/drop off.

The Sparwood Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to refuse competition entry to any participant with inappropriate scarecrow display.
